

# Health and Wellness Policy

Last Updated May 11, 2022

1. All program participants, staff and volunteers shall not attend the program if they feel sick or unwell, unless their symptoms are related to a known, pre-existing medication condition. Any child who is ill and unable to participate fully in regular activities should be cared for at home.
2. For as long as the tool remains available, all program participants, staff and volunteers shall complete the [Ontario Government COVID School and Child Care Screening](#) before arriving at the program, and shall follow the isolation and other instructions given by the tool.
3. The program shall follow all Ontario Public Health and Ottawa Public Health guidelines and requirements that apply to it.
4. All program participants, staff and volunteers are encouraged to use good hand hygiene practices while at the program. Hand sanitizer is always available.
5. If a child becomes ill while at the program, their parent or guardian will be notified immediately and asked to collect them or arrange to have them collected as soon as possible.
